The INUS essay award

Purpose

- Recognize outstanding research in Neuro-Urology
- Promote health care professionals performing research in Neuro-Urology

The INUS essay award

Eligibility

- Primary author (first author) is ≤ 40 years of age as of October 31.
- Submitted essay represents original unpublished research not under consideration for publication. Prior congress abstract submission is acceptable.

The INUS essay award

Submission requirements

- Single pdf file of scientific manuscript following the author guidelines and word limits for BJUI (<https://onlinelibrary.wiley.com/page/journal/1464410x/homepage/ForAuthors.html>).
- Submission deadline: October 31 each year

The INUS essay award

Awarding

- Best 3 submitted essays have the chance to enter review process for publication in BJUI
- Best submitted essay will be award winner. To receive the award (1000 EUR), the primary author (first author) needs to present his work in person at the next INUM.

The INUS essay award

Review and awarding process

What: submission of articles ("essays") through INUS web page

When: until October 31st each year

Who: applicants



What: review and ranking of submissions with selection of **best 3 articles**

When: until November 30th each year

Who: Blayne Welk and team (2 INUS members)



Best article (= first rank submission) is the award winner, the author will present his work at next INUM: 20 minutes presentation incl. discussion moderated by Blayne Welk



What: transfer of best 3 articles to BJUI for review for publication (if authors agree)

When: until November 30th each year

Who: Blayne Welk and team (same as for essay award)
